Wyre forest have directed me to Stourport town council, not sure if you can help with this issue or point me in the right direction please?

The allotments on kings way mean that often there are several cars parked on the road near the allotments which is already quite narrow and has a 60 mph speed limit. Also linked with the fact that this lane gets a substantial amount of traffic, due to both the nature reserve where people drive to to walk and the sports club which houses, athletics, netball, hockey, cycling and many other sporting events. This coupled with the Stourport high school entrance being on the lane also. When cars are parked in the roadside it makes the road hazardous for walkers, and cars alike.

As the allotments are next to the disused golf course which I believe belongs to were forest, surely creation of a car park on this land to serve the allotments would be a sensible solution to this problem. The nature of the allotments means that most people with them drive to them as they have tools and materials they need to carry to look after them.

There is a lay-by which seems to be used, but only space for about 3 cars, certainly not enough space to serve the allotments

As a local resident I am concerned and would like to see a long term solution to the problem for everyone's safety
